## SCHOLARSHIP POLICY

The first of its kind in Malabar, Providence Women's College, since its inception seventy years ago, has been committed socially to improving the lot of women belonging to varied socio-economic circumstances. In addition to ensuring quality education for all its students, the college pays special attention to see to it that the students from economically and socially weaker strata of the society get equitable distribution of scholarships. Based on their socio-economic background and merit, students are assisted in applying for and availing numerous scholarships offered by the state and central governments. Student support systems provide students with all information regarding various scholarships and grants from time to time and help them apply for the same on time.

Also, the college ensures that scholarships and prizes in cash and kind, fee concession, bookships, freeships etc.. are awarded to deserving students under both government and non-governmental schemes.

### **'E-Grantz' SCHOLARSHIPS**

E-grantz is web based solutions for the timely disbursement of educational assistance to all eligible students of UG, PG and PhD level, which is independent to availing other eligible scholarships.

### **Fee Concession to SC/ST/OEC/ OBC/General students**

All students belonging to SC/ST/OEC are eligible for full tuition fee concession, monthly stipend, annual lump sum grant, university exam fee concession and hostel fee concession, if needed.

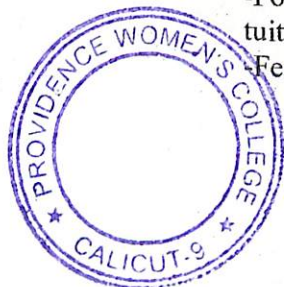
**E-Grantz:** For students pursuing post-matric courses approved by the University / Board  
**Eligibility:** Students pursuing post-matric courses approved by the university / board. Students admitted under merit and reservation quota. Students who belong to the categories of Scheduled castes, other eligible communities, OBCs and other communities who are socially and economically backward including forward castes. Students whose attendance is not below 75% at the end of each month

**Income Limit:** Scheduled castes and Scheduled Tribes no income limit, OBC (H), OEC  
Income limit : 6,00,000/- and OBC & General Income Limit: Rs.1,00,000/-

-For Degree Courses: Reimbursement of tuition fee, special fee and exam fee subject to income limit.

-For PG and Professional courses: Lump sum grant, monthly stipend, reimbursement of tuition fee, special fee and exam subject to income limit.

Fee is sanctioned once in an Academic year and paid to institution's Account.





### **Fee Concession to other students**

All other students whose parental annual income does not exceed Rs. 1,00,000/- limits are eligible for full fee concession and university examination fee for Under Graduate and Post Graduate courses respectively.

### **Other Fee Concessions and Scholarship**

#### **1. Kerala State Higher Education Council Scholarship (HECS)**

Eligibility: First year degree students of Science, Humanities, Social Science, Business Studies. Qualifying marks in previous examination: For SC/ST 45% in Science and 40% in other subjects. For others 50% in Science and 45% in other subjects. Scholarship Amount: For UG Rs.12000 for first year; Rs.18,000 for second year (1st Renewal); and Rs.24,000 per year (2nd Renewal) for final year; Post Graduation (for continuing education) – Rs.40,000 for first year (3rd Renewal) and Rs.60,000 for second year (4th Renewal).

#### **2. Merit Scholarship to the Children of School Teachers (MSCT)**

Eligibility: Children of Primary and Secondary School Teachers only are eligible. Scholarship Amount: For UG and PG Rs. 50 per month for 3 years and 2 years respectively.

#### **3. State Merit Scholarship (SMS)**

Eligibility: Applicant should have scored 50% or above in the qualifying exam and should be first year student of UG or PG. Annual income of the parents/guardian from all sources should not exceed Rs.1,00,000/-. Scholarship Amount: For UG Rs. 1250 per annum for 3 years. For PG Rs.1500 per annum for 2 years.

#### **4. Hindi Scholarship (HS)**

Eligibility: Hindi must be one of the subjects in the present studying course. Only I year students are eligible for applying the scholarship. Scholarship Amount: For UG Rs. 500 per month for 3 years; For PG Rs. 1000 per month for 2 years.

#### **5. Suvarna Jubilee Merit Scholarship (SJMS)**

Eligibility: should be first year students of UG or PG. should belong to BPL family. Should have scored 50% or above in the qualifying examination. Scholarship Amount: For UG and PG Rs. 10000 per annum or 3 years and 2 years.

#### **6. Blind/PH Scholarship (BPHFC)**

Eligibility: Blind/PH/Deaf students studying in UG and PG. Financial support: Fee Charges for Blind students with family annual income below Rs. 2.5 lakhs. Hostel charges for all PH students who are hostellers and whose family annual income is below Rs. 4.50 lakhs. Boarding charges for all PH students who are day scholars and whose family annual income is below Rs.4.50 lakhs. Can apply as fresh in all academic.

### 7. District Merit Scholarship (DMS) Renewal

**Eligibility:** Continued from +2 level up to UG level. Should have scored A Plus in all subjects in the SSLC Examination March 2013, conducted by Board of Public Examinations, Kerala State. Scholarship amount: Rs. 1250 per annum for 3 years.

### 8. SNEHAPOORVAM scholarship of Kerala Social Security Mission

**Eligibility:** Orphans (die either father or mother) who are living in the family, with their relatives, friends, or the support of the community. Scholarship amount: for UG and PG students, Rs.10,000/- per annum for 3 years and 2 years respectively.

**How to apply:** Eligible candidates should fill up the application form in the prescribed format (link given below).

Then submit the application form along with relevant documents to the College office for further process (on-line entry, verification, and submission to KSSM office)

**Documents required:**

- Application form (mention the date of joining in the course)
- Aadhar card, Parent death certificate, BPL certificate, Income Proof
- Educational certificate, Bank Details (joint account of student and guardian)

### 9. ASPIRE scholarship for PG/M.Phil/Ph.D programmes

**Eligibility:** Meritorious students of the University Departments / Colleges under the University of Calicut for pursuing short term internships/projects in institutions other than their parent College/University department.

**Award:** Rs.8000/- p.m, for internship/ project undertaken within the state and Rs.10,000/- for internship/ project undertaken outside the state. The Scholarship will be provided for minimum period of one month for P.G. Course and a maximum period of 4 months for M.Phil and Ph.D courses (at a single stretch or in 2 phases) depending upon the proposal.

### 10. C.H. Muhammedkoya Scholarship (CHMS)

**Eligibility:** Should belong to Muslim, Latin, and Converted Christian Community and should be a native of Kerala. Should be a girl student studying for the first year graduation or higher courses. Should have scored 50% or above in the qualifying examination. Annual income of the parent/guardian should not exceed Rs.6 lakhs. Scholarship Amount: For UG: Rs.4000 per annum for 3 years For PG: Rs.5000 per annum for 2 years.

### 11. Prof. Joseph Mundassery Scholarsip (PJMS)

**Eligibility:** Meritorious students of Muslim, Cristian, Sikkh, Buddah, Parsis, Jains community who studying in BA/BSc/B.Com in Arts/science colleges

**Award:** Rs. 15000/- each given to outgoing students, scores 80% in UG final year examination and 75% in PG final year examination.

**12. Kerala State Backward Classes Development Corporation (KSBCDC) Scholarship**

The economically backward OBC students will get educational scholarships and competitive assistance for their studies. Annual income of the parents/guardian from all sources should not exceed Rs.1,20,000/-

Scholarship amount: Rs. 5000/- per year to Undergraduate & post graduate level for 3 years and 2 years respectively.

**13. PRATHIBHA Scholarship (KSCSTE, Govt. of Kerala)**

Eligibility: The scholarship offered to meritorious BSc students of Botany, Biotechnology, Chemistry, Mathematics, Physics, and Zoology; should have qualified Higher Secondary Board Examination with minimum 90% marks or equivalent grade for all subjects put together and minimum 90% marks or equivalent grade for all Science subjects put together. (For SC/ST reservation category, the eligibility is stipulated to minimum marks of 80% or equivalent grade for all subjects in total and minimum 80% marks or equivalent grade for all Science subjects in total.

The objective of the programme is to motivate bright students to Higher studies in Basic and Natural Sciences by awarding them Scholarships. Prathibha Scholars are also provided opportunities to attend Science orientation programmes in reputed research laboratories in the state so as to introduce themselves to cutting edge areas of research and interact with pioneers in Science. The selected students are initially eligible for scholarship for 3-year U.G. programme. The scholarship could be continued for 2-year P.G. / 4th & 5th years of Integrated P.G./ 1st and 2<sup>nd</sup> years of Integrated Ph.D. subject to the guidelines of the scheme.

**14. INSPIRE Scholarship (DST, Govt. of India)**

The scholarship offered to pursue undergraduate (UG) studies and continued up to postgraduate (PG) studies, is based on Class 12th standard examination results (top 1%) of respective Boards or within eligible rank in chosen few competitive examinations such as JEE (main), JEE (advanced), NEET (AIPMT) and securing admission in science stream (in any of science course or its combination out of 18 identified subjects) at any recognized colleges or universities or academic institutions in the country.

**15. Post Metric Scholarship (PMS)**

Eligibility: Students belonging to economically weaker sections of minority community (Muslims & Christians). 50% or equivalent grade in the previous final examination and the annual income of the parents/guardian from all sources should not exceed Rs. 2 lakhs. Scholarship Amount: Rs.5000 per annum for UG and PG students and maintenance allowance of Rs. 570/- per month for Hosteller & Rs. 300/- per month for Day Scholar.

**16. PG Indira Gandhi Scholarship for Single Girl Child**

Eligibility: Any single girl child, being the only child of her parents, is eligible to apply for the PG scholarship scheme. The scheme is applicable to such a single girl child who has taken admission to the first year master's degree programmes. The age of the girl student should not exceed 30 years at the time of admission. Scholarship Rates: Rs. 2,000/- per month for a period of two years only (10 months in the year) i.e. full duration of a PG course.

**17. Post Metric Scholarships for Students with Disabilities (PMSD)**

Eligibility: The Scholarships are to provide financial assistance to the parents of students with disabilities for studying in post-metric level. The financial assistance includes scholarship, book grant, escort/reader allowance, etc. Selection of the beneficiaries under these two scholarship schemes is on the basis of merit.

**18. Central Sector Scholarship (CSS)**

Eligibility: applicant should have passed the Senior School Certificate Examination conducted by CBSE and have secured the total aggregate marks (in first five subjects) equal or above the following minimum marks as per the stream opted by the applicant. Annual income of the parents/guardian from all sources should not exceed Rs. 4.50 lakhs. Scholarship Amount: For UG 1000/- per month. For PG Rs.2000/- per month.

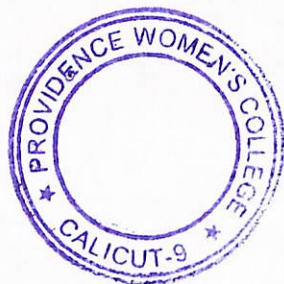
