SCHOLARSHIP POLICY

The first of its kind in Malabar, Providence Women's College, since its inception seventy years ago, has been committed socially to improving the lot of women belonging to varied socio-economic circumstances. In addition to ensuring quality education for all its students, the college pays special attention to see to it that the students from economically and socially weaker strata of the society get equitable distribution of scholarships. Based on their socio-economic background and merit, students are assisted in applying for and availing numerous scholarships offered by the state and central governments. Student support systems provide students with all information regarding various scholarships and grants from time to time and help them apply for the same on time.

Also, the college ensures that scholarships and prizes in cash and kind, fee concession, bookships, freeships etc.. are awarded to deserving students under both government and non-governmental schemes.

'E-Grantz' SCHOLARSHIPS

E-grantz is web based solutions for the timely disbursement of educational assistance to all eligible students of UG, PG and PhD level, which is independent to availing other eligible scholarships.

Fee Concession to SC/ST/OEC/ OBC/General students

All students belonging to SC/ST/OEC are eligible for full tuition fee concession, monthly stipend, annual lump sum grant, university exam fee concession and hostel fee concession, if needed.

E-Grantz: For students pursuing post-matric courses approved by the University / Board Eligibility: Students pursuing post-matric courses approved by the university / board. Students admitted under merit and reservation quota. Students who belong to the categories of Scheduled castes, other eligible communities, OBCs and other communities who are socially and economically backward including forward castes. Students whose attendance is not below 75% at the end of each month

Income Limit: Scheduled castes and Scheduled Tribes no income limit, OBC (H), OEC Income limit: 6,00,000/- and OBC & General Income Limit: Rs.1,00,000/-

-For Degree Courses: Reimbursement of tuition fee, special fee and exam fee subject to income limit.

-For PG and Professional courses: Lump sum grant, monthly stipend, reimbursement of tuition fee, special fee and exam subject to income limit.

Fee is sanctioned once in an Academic year and paid to institution's Account.

Fee Concession to other students

All other students whose parental annual income does not exceed Rs. 1,00,000/- limits are eligible for full fee concession and university examination fee for Under Graduate and Post Graduate courses respectively.

Other Fee Concessions and Scholarship

1. Kerala State Higher Education Council Scholarship (HECS)

Eligibility: First year degree students of Science, Humanities, Social Science, Business Studies. Qualifying marks in previous examination: For SC/ST 45% in Science and 40% in other subjects. For others 50% in Science and 45% in other subjects. Scholarship Amount: For UG Rs.12000 for first year; Rs.18,000 for second year (1st Renewal); and Rs.24,000 per year (2nd Renewal) for final year; Post Graduation (for continuing education) – Rs.40,000 for first year (3rd Renewal) and Rs.60,000 for second year (4th Renewal).

Eligibility: Children of Primary and Secondary School Teachers only are eligible. Scholarship Amount: For UG and PG Rs. 50 per month for 3 years and 2 years respectively.

3. State Merit Scholarship (SMS)

Eligibility: Applicant should have scored 50% or above in the qualifying exam and should be first year student of UG or PG. Annual income of the parents/guardian from all sources should not exceed Rs.1,00,000/-. Scholarship Amount: For UG Rs. 1250 per annum for 3 years. For PG Rs.1500 per annum for 2 years.

4. Hindi Scholarship (HS)

Eligibility: Hindi must be one of the subjects in the present studying course. Only I year students are eligible for applying the scholarship. Scholarship Amount: For UG Rs. 500 per month for 3 years; For PG Rs. 1000 per month for 2 years.

Boarding charges for all PH students who are day scholars and whose family annual income is below Rs.4.50 lakhs. Can apply as fresh in all academic.

8. SNEHAPOORVAM scholarship of Kerala Social Security Mission

9. ASPIRE scholarship for PG/M.Phil/Ph.D programmes

Eligibility: Meritorious students of the University Departments / Colleges under the University of Calicut for pursuing short term internships/projects in institutions other than their parent College/University department.

Award: Rs.8000/- p.m, for internship/ project undertaken within the state and Rs.10,000/- for internship/ project undertaken outside the state. The Scholarship will be provided for minimum period of one month for P.G. Course and a maximum period of 4 months for M.Phil and Ph.D courses (at a single stretch or in 2 phases) depending upon the proposal.


11. Prof. Joseph Mundassery Scholarsip (PJMS)

13. PRATHIBHA Scholarship (KSCSTE, Govt. of Kerala)

Eligibility: The scholarship offered to meritorious BSc students of Botany, Biotechnology, Chemistry, Mathematics, Physics, and Zoology; should have qualified Higher Secondary Board Examination with minimum 90% marks or equivalent grade for all subjects put togetherand minimum 90% marks or equivalent grade for all Science subjects put together. (For SC/ST reservation category, the eligibility is stipulated to minimum marks of 80% or equivalent grade for all subjects in total and minimum 80% marks or equivalent grade for all Science subjects intotal.

The objective of the programme is to motivate bright students to Higher studies in Basic and Natural Sciences by awarding them Scholarships. Prathibha Scholars are also provided opportunities to attend Science orientation programmes in reputed research laboratories in the state so as to introduce themselves to cutting edge areas of research and interact with pioneers in Science. The selected students are initially eligible for scholarship for 3-year U.G. programme. The scholarship could be continued for 2-year P.G. / 4th & 5th years of Integrated P.G. / 1st and 2nd years of Integrated Ph.D. subject to the guidelines of the scheme. 14. INSPIRE Scholarship (DST, Govt. of India)

PG Indira Gandhi Scholarship for Single Girl Child

Eligibility: Any single girl child, being the only child of her parents, is eligible to apply for the PG scholarship scheme. The scheme is applicable to such a single girl child who has taken admission to the first year master's degree programmes. The age of the girl student should not exceed 30 years at the time of admission.
