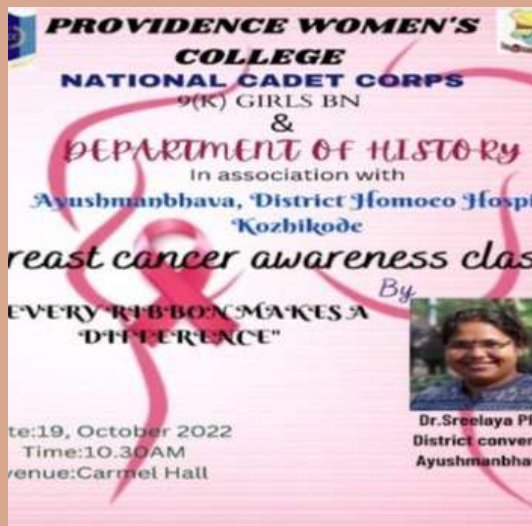
## NATIONAL WEBINAR

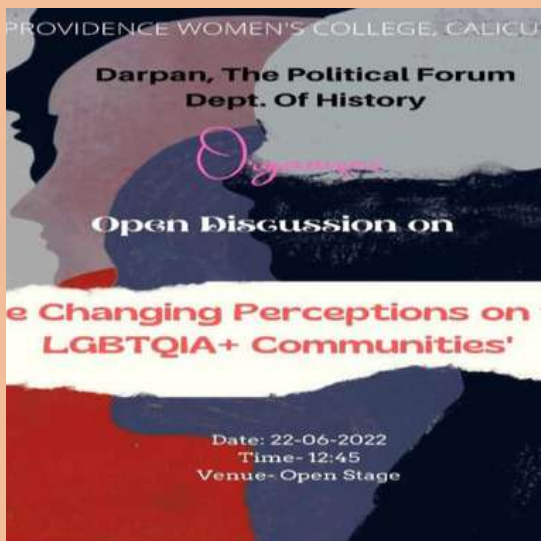




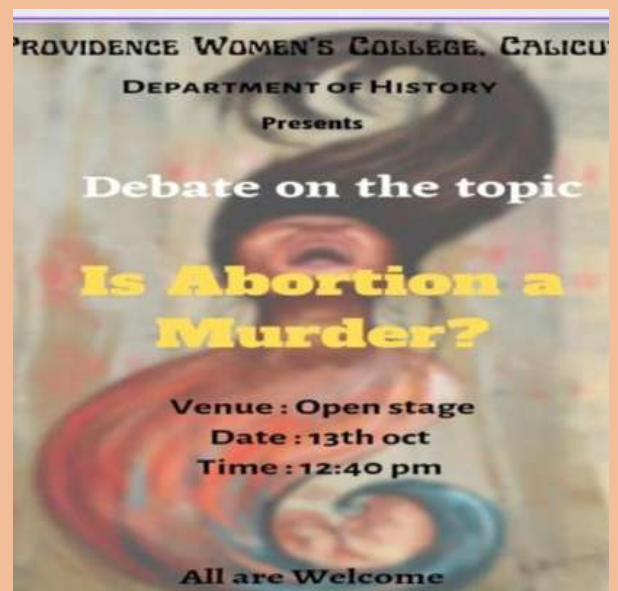
# Activities of the Clubs

## 2.NAATARVIVU( THE FOLKLORE CLUB)

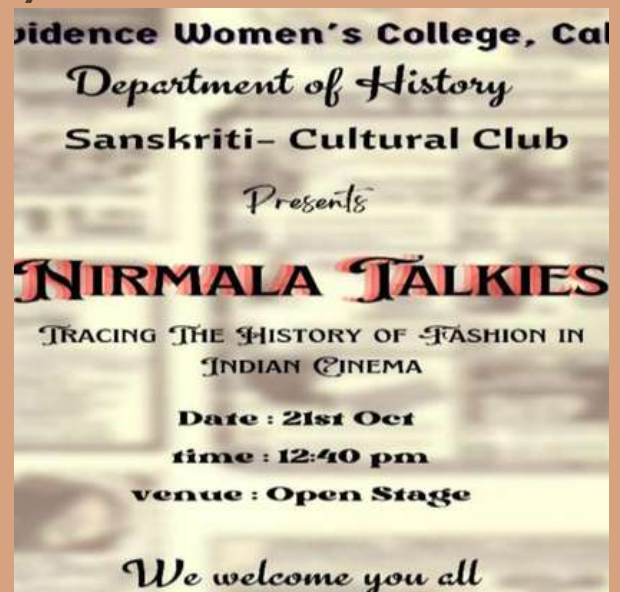
In connection with the Malayalm Week Celebrations, the club organized 'Chimnamakali' in association with the Govt. Folklore Academy, Kannur.

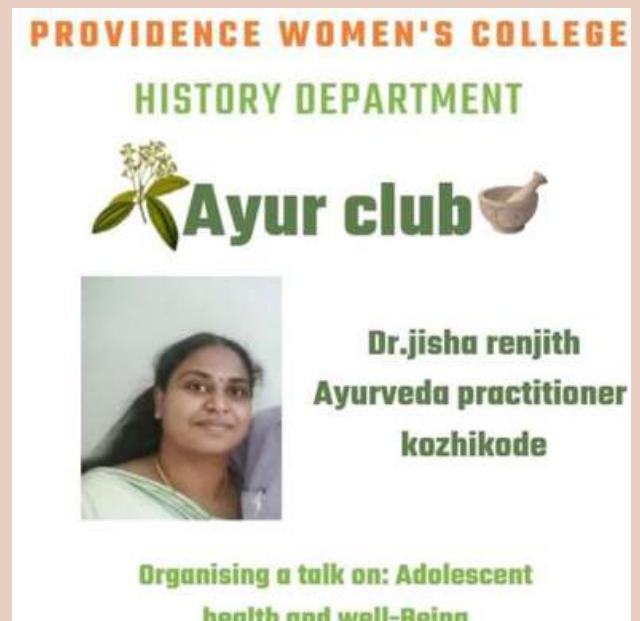


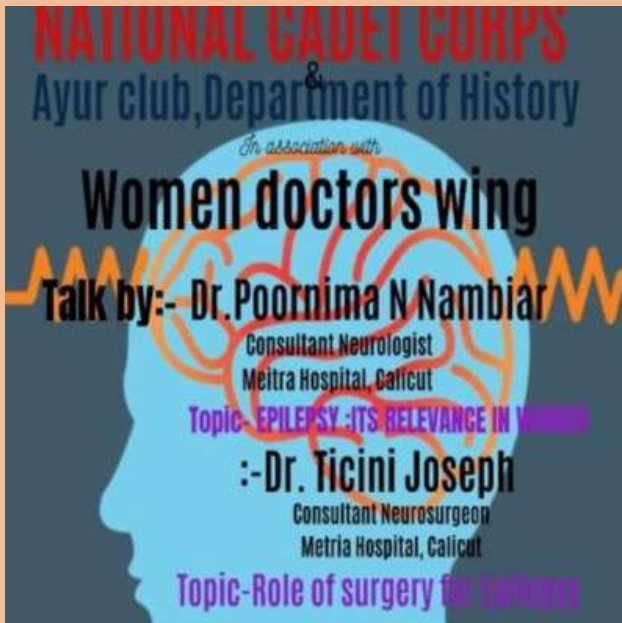
## 4. Ayur (the Health Club)

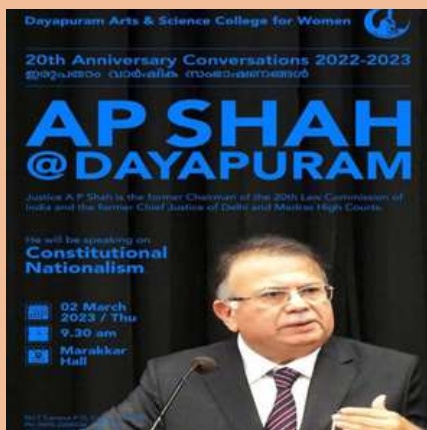

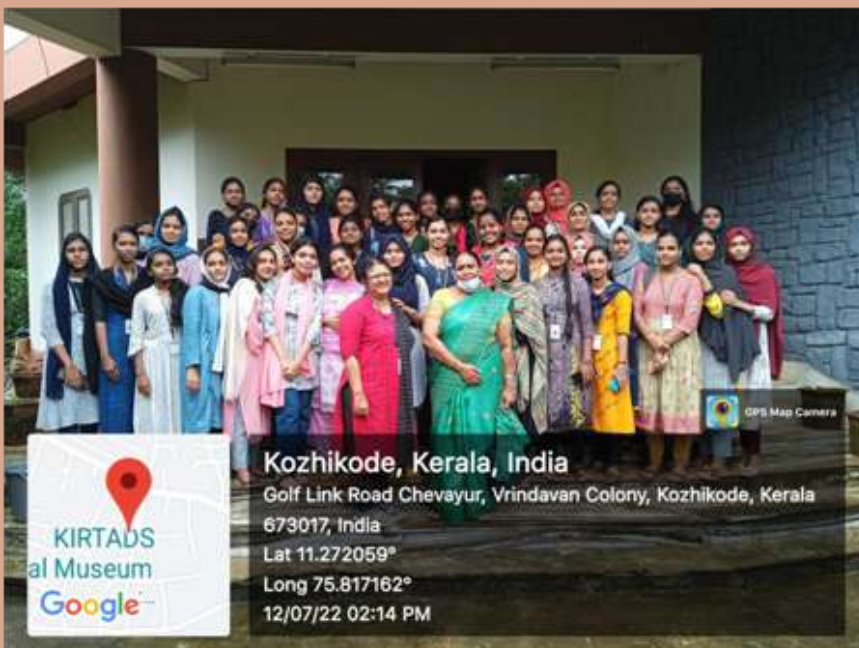
# Experiential Learning
