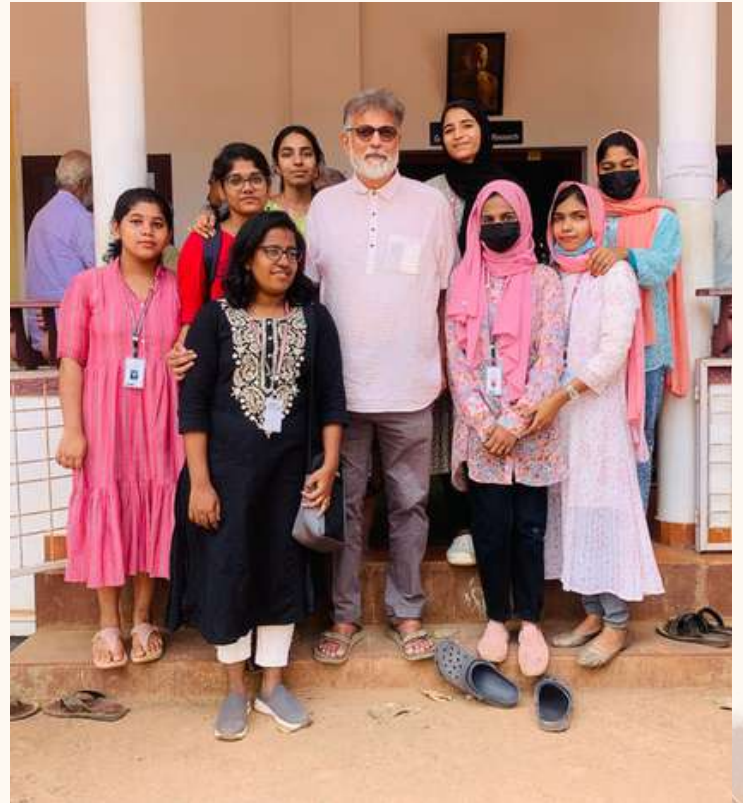

CIGI Sunrise Fellowship is a fellowship worth 1 lakh provided by CIGI, Chevayur for UG 1st year students.





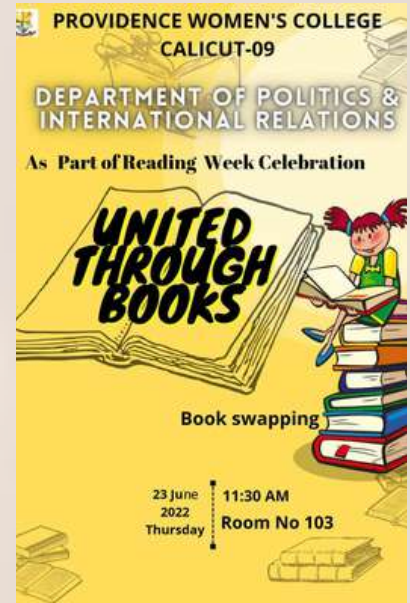

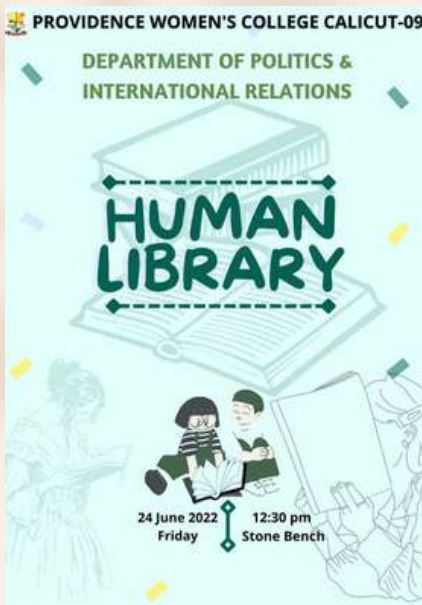
The Anganwadi visit was conducted as part of reading week celebration.

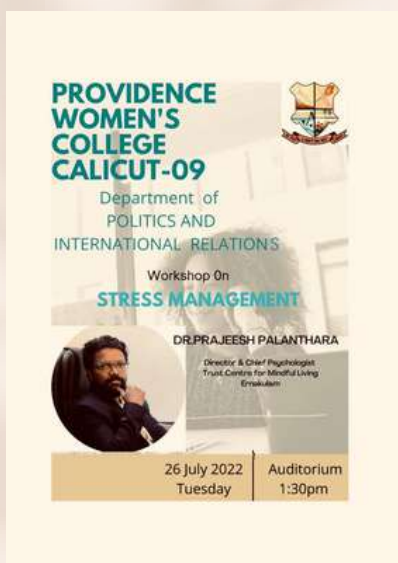

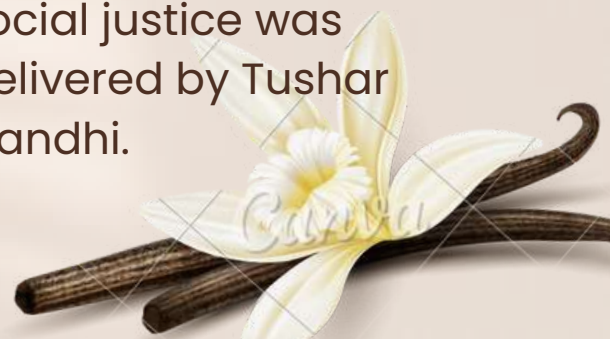
## AP Shah Talk Show Tushar Gandhi Talk Show








