CIRCULAR

CONDONATION OF ATTENDANCE SHORTAGE

- 1. A student shall be permitted to appear for the end-semester examination of a specific course to acquire the credits only if she has minimum 75% attendance (has completed minimum 75% of the prescribed classroom activities in physical, online, or blended modes, including any compensating activities as specified by the faculty of that particular course).
- 2. Records for classroom participation shall be maintained by the faculty concerned.
- Condonation of attendance shortage on medical grounds to a maximum of 10% in the 3. case of single condonation and 20% in the case of double condonation in a semester shall be granted by the College on the remittance of the required fee by the candidate.
- Students can avail condonation of shortage of attendance on medical grounds in a 4. maximum of four semesters during the entire programme (Either four single condonations or one double condonation and two single condonations during the entire programme).
- 5. If a student fails to get the required attendance within condonable limit, she can move to the next semester only if she has acquired at least 50% attendance. In such cases, a provisional exam registration is compulsory.
- Such a student can write the examination for the entire courses of the semester, in which 6. shortage of attendance occurs, as supplementary examination only after the completion of the entire programme.
- If the attendance is less than 50%, the student is ineligible to continue the programme 7. and has to seek readmission.
- A medical certificate from a registered medical practitioner is mandatory for the 8. candidate to seek condonation for attendance shortage.

*Fee Structure

a) Rs 1010/- for shortage up to 10% (65% to 74% attendance)

b) Rs 1315/- for shortage above 10% up to 20% (55% to 64% attendance)

*Fee will be decided by the Academic Council from time to time.
